## Government's Net Revenue Collection: The First 5 Months of Fiscal Year 2019 (October 2018 - February 2019)

Mr. Lavaron Sangsnit, Director-General of the Fiscal Policy Office and Spokesperson of the Ministry of Finance, stated that the government's net revenue collection in the first 5 months of fiscal year 2019 (October 2018 – February 2019), was 986,000 million baht, which was 75,568 million baht or 8.3% higher than the same period of last year. Revenue collection from Revenue Department, remittances from State-owned enterprises and revenue collection from Excise Department, were 52,881, 22,054 and 16,222 million baht or 8.3%, 34.2% and 7.4% higher than the same period of last year.

When compared to MOF's estimation, which is used for the purpose of revenue monitoring and evaluation by taking current economic situations and variables that affect government's revenue collection into consideration, net revenue collection in the first 5 months of fiscal year 2019 was 22,476 million baht or 2.3% higher than estimated. Revenue collection from all departments were in accordance with MOF's estimation with the exception of revenue collection from Customs Department and remittances from State-owned enterprises which were slightly lower than estimation due to lower value of actual imports than estimated and deferments of some remittance schedule of State-owned enterprises. Nevertheless, revenue collection from Customs Department and remittances from State-owned enterprises were still higher than revenue target by 3,929 and 14,222 million Baht or 9.3% and 19.6%, respectively.
