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## Government's Net Revenue Collection: The First 2 Months of Fiscal Year 2023 (October – November 2022)

Mr. Pornchai Thiraveja, Director General of the Fiscal Policy Office and Spokesperson of the Ministry of Finance, stated that the government's net revenue collection in the first 2 months of fiscal year 2023 (October – November 2022) was 424,738 million Baht. The collected revenue was 55,418 million Baht or 15.0% higher than target and 18.5% higher than the same period of the previous year. The revenues from Other Government Agencies exceeded target due to special revenues from the remittance of extra-budgetary fund's excess liquidity, cellular royalty according to Section 84 of the Operation of the Sound Broadcasting Service and the Television Broadcasting Service Act B.E. 2551 from National Telecom Public Company Limited, and income from FM radio frequency licenses' auction. The remittances from State-Owned Enterprises were higher than target due to deferred remittances from the previous fiscal year. The collected revenue from the Revenue Department, especially Corporate Income Tax and Personal Income Tax, was higher than target following economic expansion. Moreover, the revenue from the Customs Department exceeded the targets due to special revenue from additional import duties from a court ruling.

Nevertheless, the collected revenue from the Excise Department was lower than target as a result of a temporary tax cut on diesel to alleviate the impact of high energy price. Excluding special revenues from Other Government Agencies and the Customs Department, the government's net revenue collection was 22,007 million Baht or 6.0% higher than target and 9.1% higher than the same period of the previous year.
