General Government Fiscal Balance Report (GFS Basis)¹ :

The First Quarter of the Fiscal Year 2023

In the first quarter of fiscal year 2023 (October – December 2022), general government revenue was 805,281 million Baht, which was 54,596 million Baht (7.3 percent) higher than the same period of the last year. The main reason was from the higher revenue collection of central government (especially income base tax (net), remittance from other government agencies and state-owned enterprises and import duty (net)). On the other hand, general government expenditure in the first quarter of fiscal year 2023 was 1,160,021 million Baht, which was 109,794 million Baht (8.6 percent) lower than the same period of the last year. The main reason was the loan's disbursement under the Emergency Decree Authorising the Ministry of Finance to Raise Loans to Solve Problems, to Remedy, and Restore the Economy and Society as Affected by the Coronavirus Disease Pandemic, B.E. 2563 (2020) and Emergency Decree Authorising the Ministry of Finance to Raise Additional Loans to Solve Economic and Social Problems Affected by the Coronavirus Disease Pandemic, B.E. 2564 (2021) which was lower than the same period of the last year. Therefore, general government balance was in deficit of 354,740 million Baht, which accounted for 1.9 percent of GDP. Meanwhile, the consolidated general government primary balance, which excludes interest payment to reflect the substantive performance and the direction of fiscal policy, was also in deficit of 269,432 million Baht, or 1.5 percent of GDP.
